- 5 Apply the principles of law to problems associated with business and business transactions.

Indicative Module Content

Sources of law; employment law; law of obligations; constitution of business organisations; company structure; insolvency and administration; fraudulent and criminal behaviour.

Module Delivery

The module is delivered in Blended Learning mode using structured online learning materials/activities and directed study, facilitated by regular online tutor support. Workplace Mentor support and work-based learning activities will allow students to contextualise this learning to their own workplace. Face-to-face engagement occurs through annual induction sessions, employer work-site visits, and modular on-campus workshops.
