### Aims of Module

To develop a knowledge and understanding of the principles of the law of delict and the relevant case law.

### Learning Outcomes for Module

On completion of this module, students are expected to be able to:

- 1 Identify the key issues of law and fact arising from legal problems relating to the law of delict.
- 2 Analyse and evaluate the legal and factual issues relevant to the solution of the problems of the law of delict
- 3 Evaluate and apply the principles of the law of delict applicable to the problems of the law of delict.
- 4 Explain and communicate the key issues of law relating to the law of delict to an audience
- 5 Develop the transferable skills of good communication and effective presentation to an audience within the context of the law of delict

### Indicative Module Content

This module will study the fundamental concepts of delict, types of liability; common law and statutory liability including a study of the Occupier's Liability (Scotland) Act; negligence; liability for economic loss; harm to reputation (defamation); nervous shock (including liability to the relatives of the victim); bodily integrity and consent for medical procedures; professional liability; defences; limitation and prescription; and remedies.

### Module Delivery

The module will be delivered by lecture and by seminars in which students will be required to analyse and apply the law to set practical situations.
