#### **Aims of Module**

To provide students with an understanding of the key concepts of audit theory and its practical application.

- Demonstrate knowledge of the legislation governing auditing and the regulatory framework governing audit and assurance.
- 3 Discuss the auditor's process for planning an audit and assessing the risk.
- 4 Critically appraise the differing responsibilities of management and the auditor in relation to the prevention and detection of fraud.

Introduction to Audit; Appointment, Resignation and Removal; Ethics and Independence; Duty of Care; True and Fair; Risk and Materiality; Fraud; Audit Planning; Internal Controls; Internal Audit

### **Module Delivery**

The module is delivered in Blended Learning mode using structured online learning materials/activities and directed study, facilitated by regular online tutor support. Workplace mentor support and work-based learning activities will allow students to contextualise this learning to their own workplace. Face-to-face engagement occurs through modular on-campus workshops.
