To develop the skills to be able to successfully complete an integrated case study within a simulated business context based on the material drawn from the CIMA Operational and Management level modules, P1, E1, F1, P2, E2 and F2.

- 2 Apply technical knowledge and insights obtained through study of the CIMA P1, E1, F1, P2, E2 and F2 modules to effectively evaluate the case study situation.
- 3 Discuss the issues raised by the case study simulation using the professional language of accounting and business, providing recommendations as required.
- 4 Address any ethical issues raised by the case study simulation.

This module integrates material covered by both CIMA Operational and Management level modules P1, E1, F1, P2, E2 and F2.
