## **Indicative Module Content**

The module will be based on a case study drawn from real life examples and will require the preparation of an extensive report.

## **Module Delivery**

Students will be provided with a case study based on issues which arise in "real life" and set a task based on assessing those issues. Students will be given guidance on the skills required to complete the task by way of recorded lectures.
