The content of the module will include key issues from the perspective of sport coaching. The issues selected will be chosen each year to ensure the topics remain current and pertinent to sport coaching. Development of communication and debating skills including, overview, rebuttal and summary.

Blended delivery comprising on campus and online learning and engagement. This will include a Keynote lecture to introduce each of the topics and tutorials to support those topics.
