### **Aims of Module**

To develop a knowledge and understanding of the principles of the law of delict and the relevant case law.

- 4 Explain and communicate the key issues of law relating to the law of delict to an audience.
- Develop the transferable skills of good communication and effective presentation to an audience within the context of the law of delict.

## **Indicative Module Content**

This module will study the fundamental concepts of delict, types of liability; common law and statutory liability including a study of the Occupier's Liability (Scotland) Act; negligence; liability for economic loss; harm to reputation (defamation); nervous shock (including liability to the relatives of the victim); bodily integrity and consent for medical procedures; professional liability; defences; limitation and prescription; and remedies.

### **Module Delivery**

The module will be delivered by lecture and by seminars in which students will be required to analyse and apply the law to set practical situations.
