# **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

This practice module enables the student to select a preferred placement environment. The aim of this module is to enable the student to select this placement in line with what may be their potential preferred area of practice when applying for posts as a registrant on completion of their programme. It is designed to enhance graduate employability. In both BN and BN HONS pathways, the student undertakes the four week placement on the basis of a 37.5 hour week and must achieve a minumum of 100 hours attendance in order to be assessed - the assessment is based on a pass/fail, measured against criteria reflective of the four NMC domains.
