The Criminal Justice dimension of child protection. Through Care Provision, Youth Justice, Assessment of Children's Needs, Risk Assessment in Child Protection, Parental Substance Misuse and the Impact on Children. Reflects the knowledge, skills and professional confidence and competence requirements around engagement with public protection. The module is delivered and underpinned by a commitment to core social work values of respect, individualisation, empowerment, anti discriminatory and anti oppressive principles.

The module is based on directed and private study supplemented by lectures, seminars and tutorials. Introductory materials are linked to course material, directed and private study is supported by tutorials
