Aims of Module

To provide the student with the ability to integrate the knowledge, understanding and skills developed throughout Stages 1 and 2 to undertake pre-contract cost and carbon planning and controlling activities for a simulated construction project and demonstrate professional development.

Learning Outcomes for Module

On completion of this module, students are expected to be able to:

- 1 Calculate the total cost and carbon of a construction project using historic data
- 2 Produce different levels of cost/carbon plans for a construction project
- 3 Revise cost/carbon plans to reflect the detailed designs of a construction project
- Write recommendations to reconcile the difference between the cost/carbon plans and pre-tender estimate figures
- Write a reflective account of how their learning from previous modules and CPDs have contributed to their academic and professional development

Indicative Module Content

This module simulates the pre-contract phase of a construction project with a focus on cost and carbon planning and controlling. Students will learn to produce different levels of cost/carbon estimates/plans during the pre-contract stage of construction projects. students are required to undertake formal and informal CPDs over the year and to submit a record of CPDs undertaken. Students will be introduced to basic research skills as part of this module which would serve as a precursor to the honours year project.

Module Delivery

This module is predominantly workshop based. Directed study to core texts and resource material will be encouraged. Students are to apply the knowledge and skills gained from modules from Stage 1 and Stage 2.
