### Aims of Module

To enable the student to demonstrate learning accrued in a practical environment. To use academic knowledge to underpin and broaden workplace skills.

### Learning Outcomes for Module

On completion of this module, students are expected to be able to:

- 1 Demonstrate the necessary skills in the following areas: Technical and Learning Skills, Staff Relations Skills, Planning and Organisational Skills, Personal and Professional Skills and Communication Skills.
- 2 Reflect on their own strengths and weaknesses as a potential professional person.
- 3 Appraise the structure and the function of the organisation in which they are placed and critically evaluate the factors which affect its performance.
- 4 Apply the theories, skills, models, concepts and principles acquired in their studies to date in the workplace.

### Indicative Module Content

The professional practice portfolio will provide evidence which combines practical skills and learning gained in the workplace with academic knowledge. Each student will draw up an agreed learning contract with the host organisation and devise a programme which will enable the learning outcomes to be achieved.

### Module Delivery

Delivery combines supervised on-the-job mentoring with guidance from a University adviser. In addition, students may be required to attend staff development workshops as designated by the host organisation.
