

RGU:UNILINK

First Group provides a shuttle bus service, No 9, between the City Centre and Garthdee campuses.

Timetable

Buses run every 10 minutes between 08.00 and 09.00 and every 15 minutes between 09.00 and 18.45 Monday to Friday. There is also a 45 minute service between 18.45 and 21.30 Monday to Friday.

Route

Buses leave from Woolmanhill Flats in John Street and travel to Garthdee via Schoolhill, Union Street and Holburn Street.

Fares

Students and staff can purchase a weekly pass which offers unlimited travel on the Unilink service. This can be purchased on a weekly basis or for a whole semester. These passes can only be purchased from one of the recognised ticket outlets (see below). Single journey or return journey tickets can be purchased on board the bus.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

First Group

As well as the RGU:Unilink service, First Group services No.1 & 2 operate from the City Centre to Garthdee. These services operate on a 10 minute frequency. CAR PARKING

City Centre Campus

Parking at the city centre campus is very limited and is only available for staff permit holders or visitors, by prior arrangement. Alternative city centre parking is available at one of the public car parks nearby.

Garthdee

Parking at the Garthdee campus is only available for permit holders and visitors. Limited permits are available on an annual basis for both staff and students. Full details can be found on the RGU Transport website at: www.rgu.ac.uk/transport

Additional parking is available around the residential streets of Garthdee. The Garthdee Controlled Parking Zone is in operation Monday to Friday between 10.00 and 16.00. Vouchers are required and these can be purchased from the following locations:

- Costa Coffee, Faculty of Health and Social Care
- Aramark Shop, Aberdeen Business School
- Aramark Refectory, Gray's School of Art
- Estates Building, Garthdee
- L & J Newsagents, Garthdee Drive
- Sunflower Cafe, Garthdee Parish Church

Vouchers cost £1.00 for up to 2 hours or £2.00 for 2-6 hours. Vouchers can be purchased individually or in books of five.

Car Share Scheme

RGU operates a Car Share scheme to discourage single occupancy cars. Car Share Teams are given priority when applying for a parking permit and also benefit from reduced rates. Full details can be found on the RGU Transport website at: www.rgu.ac.uk/transport
