

Workshop:	Introduction to web design: Dreamweaver and Fireworks Part II

Pre-requisites:	Introduction to web design: Dreamweaver and Fireworks workshop Introduction to MYSQL workshop
Necessary equipment:	Workstations with a preferably 17" screen and Macromedia Dreamweaver and Macromedia Fireworks installed. Projection equipment and white board are required at the same time.
Class Size:	The workshop is suitable for about 10 to 15 people.
Duration:	~ 2 Hours.

Macromedia Dreamweaver and Macromedia Fireworks are two professional tools that can speed up the development of web sites. The proposed hands-on workshop is presented via audio-visual instruction in "do-what-I-do" style.

This advanced workshop of two hours enhances on the topics covered in the Introduction to web design and brings in areas covered in the Introduction to MYSQL to include dynamic web site creation with PHP and HTML. For this workshop a web server setup is used a number of guest accounts on the web server and the database server.

Ideally a database course (MySQL) should be completed before this part, but alternatively a populated database can be used instead from which data is extracted.

Due to the complexity in dealing with remote services, the workshop assumes prior knowledge in HTML and remote file management and a basic grasp of sequential programming languages. In addition to HTML and CSS which are prerequisites for this workshop, SQL and PHP technology will complete the set of skills necessary to develop simple web-bourne applications.
