

<b>Workshop:</b>	<b>Introduction to web design: Dreamweaver and Fireworks</b>
<b>Tutors:</b>	<b>Frank Herrmann</b>
<b>Pre-requisites:</b>	<b>Besides basic computing skill, some knowledge and experience dealing with web page development and image editing tools would be desirable, but is not essential.</b>
<b>Necessary equipment:</b>	<b>Workstations with a preferably 17" screen and Macromedia Dreamweaver and Macromedia Fireworks installed. Projection equipment and white board are required at the same time.</b>
<b>Class Size:</b>	<b>The workshop is suitable for about 10 to 15 people.</b>
<b>Duration:</b>	<b>~ 4 Hours.</b>

Macromedia Dreamweaver and Macromedia Fireworks are two professional tools that can speed up the development of web sites. The proposed hands-on workshop is presented via audio-visual instruction in "do-what-I-do" style.

The objective is to develop, test and deploy a visually appealing Web Blog ready to be hosted on the web. The technologies introduced in this workshop are HTML and cascading stylesheets (CSS) on a level necessary to use WYSIWYG web editors.

The workshop splits into two two hour blocks with a break in between. In the first part, the graphical design for the web page will be developed. In the second part, the design will be transformed into either a web page or a Dreamweaver template
