

RGU: ACCOMMODATION

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS 2007/2008



How do I apply for student accommodation?

You will be able to go on line from the end of March 2007 onwards and apply (see www.rgu.ac.uk/roomonline). Please note that you will need to have an unconditional or conditional offer that you have firmly accepted (or an insurance offer) and that you live out with the Aberdeen City and local area for your application to be accepted.

When will I be allocated accommodation?

If your University offer is an unconditional one you will be emailed an offer of accommodation from mid June 2007 onwards. If your offer is conditional you will be emailed an offer after your offer becomes unconditional (normally mid to late August 2007).

What type of accommodation is available and where is it located?

All accommodation is in the form of self-contained, self-catering, flats with capacity from 3 up to 8 students. Most of the accommodation is within city centre locations with a small number of spaces at Garthdee.

What will it cost?

For 2007/08 the costs will be in range of:

Depending on Location

A standard room is £62.00 to £71.50 per week

An ensuite room is £79.50 to £81.50 per week

What is included with the accommodation?

All student accommodation includes the following at no extra cost:

- High speed 24/7 internet access
- Cost of all utilities
- Personal contents insurance
- Bedding packs

How long do I have to take an accommodation contract for?

All first year students are normally offered a 36 week contract which will run from approximately mid September 2007 to the end of May 2008.

What other choices are available to me?

If you wish to seek accommodation in the private sector the University can give you assistance, however, we would strongly advise you to apply for University accommodation in your first year.
