To enable the student to work in a practical environment, to consolidate and broaden their knowledge gained in academic studies.

Learning Outcomes for Module

On completion of this module, students are expected to be able to:

- 3 Assess the structure and the function of the organisation in which they are placed and critically evaluate the factors which affect its performance.

Indicative Module Content

The content of the professional placement will vary. However, each student will draw up an agreed learning contract with the host organisation and devise a programme which will enable the learning outcomes to be achieved. Students can work in a variety of professional environments related to Interior Design. For professional and practical reasons students are expected to complete a minimum of 600 hours during their industrial placement.

Module Delivery

Delivery is by means of supervised on-the-job training. In addition, students may be required to attend staff development workshops as designated by the host organisation.
