#### **Aims of Module**

To prepare healthcare professionals to assess and support individuals who present with minor illnesses.

## **Learning Outcomes for Module**

On completion of this module, students are expected to be able to:

- 1 Critically appraise holistic assessment in relation to minor illness presentations.
- 2 Critically evaluate the implications of the pathophysiological process for patients presenting with a minor illness.
- Critically evaluate the assessment and examination process and the concept of differential diagnosis in relation to minor illness management.
- 4 Critically analyse decision making processes in relation to the assessment and management of minor illness.
- Critically reflect on the role of the healthcare professional in relation to evidence based practice, legal and professional issues within the multidisciplinary team.

## **Indicative Module Content**

Consultation and History Taking; Differences across the lifespan; Communication; Pathophysiology of common minor illnesses; Examination and assessment processes; Differential diagnosis; Decision making processes; Triage; Evidence based practice; Management of minor illness; Referral; Medication management; Clinical governance; Professional issues.

The module will be delivered online, using formative activities, discussion forums and virtual classroom. Students will be provided with access to Clinicalskills.net, an online learning and teaching resource.
