### Aims of Module

To develop the student's ability to integrate and apply the required theories, principles, concepts and skills of a specialist community public health nurse in their defined area of practice.

The student will critically reflect on practice and apply core knowledge, skills and attributes required as a specialist community public health nurse in their defined area of practice including: Health profiling; Health needs assessment; Health promotion; Advanced communication skills; Multi-agency working; Interdisciplinary team working; Management and leadership; Public health; Human development; Evidence informed-decision making, professional judgement; Risk management; Continuing professional development; Critical reflection.
